#### The Attended Funeral:

*This is a funeral where family and friends have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person at the selected cemetery or crematorium.*

Funeral Directors' Fees	£1,950.00
• Taking care of all necessary legal and administrative arrangements (during normal working hours)	£500.00
• Collecting and transporting the deceased person from the place of death (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) into the funeral director's care.	£350.00
• Care of the deceased person before the funeral in appropriate facilities. The deceased will stay at Charles Rourke & Sons Funeral Home.	£300.00
• Providing a suitable simple coffin – this will be made with solid wood and oak veneers (standard width and depth only).	£500.00
• Viewing of the deceased person for family and friends, by appointment, with the funeral director (where viewing is requested by the customer).	No Charge
• At a date and time, you agree with the funeral director, taking the deceased person direct to the agreed cemetery or crematorium (normally within 15 miles of the funeral director's premises) in a hearse or other appropriate vehicle.	£300.00

#### The Unattended Funeral:

*This is a funeral where family and friends may choose to have a ceremony, event or service for the deceased person, but they do not attend the burial or cremation itself.*

Funeral Directors' Fee: £1,400.00\*

**\*Please note this does not include any burial or cremation fees**

#### Additional Funeral Director Products and Services:

*We are able to supply a range of optional, additional products and services, or to arrange (on your behalf) for a third party to supply them. Examples include:*

#### Third Party Fees You Must Pay:

##### *For Burial:*

There are fees due to local councils and private graveyards which must be paid before a grave is opened. A full list of grave fees for Newry Mourne & Down District Council can be found online at: <https://www.newrymournedown.org/municipal-cemeteries>.

Private graveyards may also have their own independent gravedigger, who will require a fee. This can be arranged with us. Private cemeteries/graveyards will have their own independent pricelist. Speak to your Funeral Director for advice on these.

*For Cremation:*

There are two crematoriums in Northern Ireland – Roselawn Crematorium and Antrim & Newtonabbey Crematorium.

As part of the application process, there are doctors' fees which must be paid to arrange a cremation. The two doctors complete two separate forms as part of the cremation application. The first doctor, who has seen & treated the deceased within the last 28 days. Then a second independent doctor. Both doctors receive £85.00 for signing cremation forms.
